

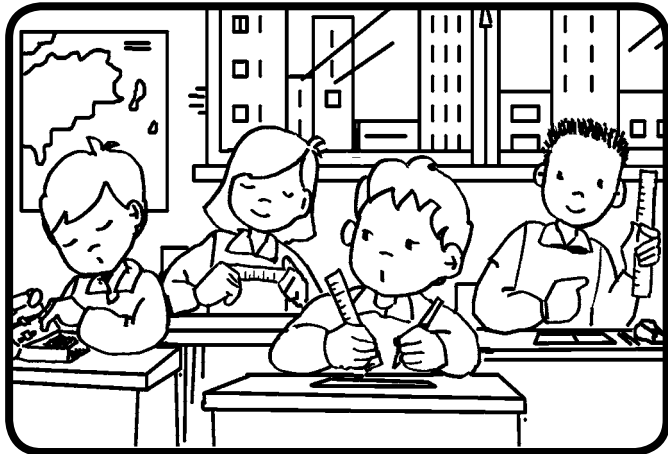
Have a big heart!

"We have to celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found." (Lk 15,32)

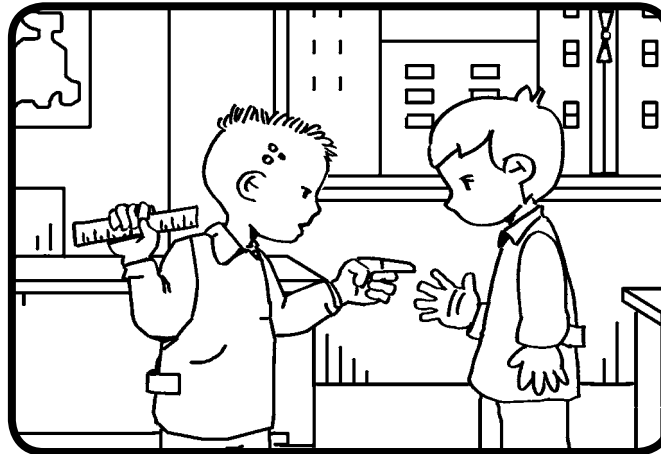

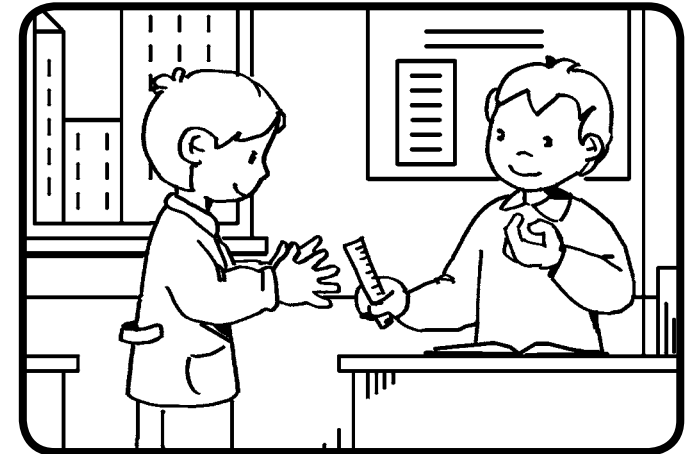
