Under the magnifying glass...

This Word of Life means that whoever loves the Son of God, and therefore keeps his commandments, is loved by the Father. The Son also loves that person and shows himself to them.

So LOVE is at the center. You can't imagine a Christian who doesn't have love in his or her heart.

It would be like a watch that has no battery.

A Christian who isn't loving all the time, doesn't deserve the name "Christian."

All of the commandments of Jesus can be summed up in one: **Love God and love your neighbor.**

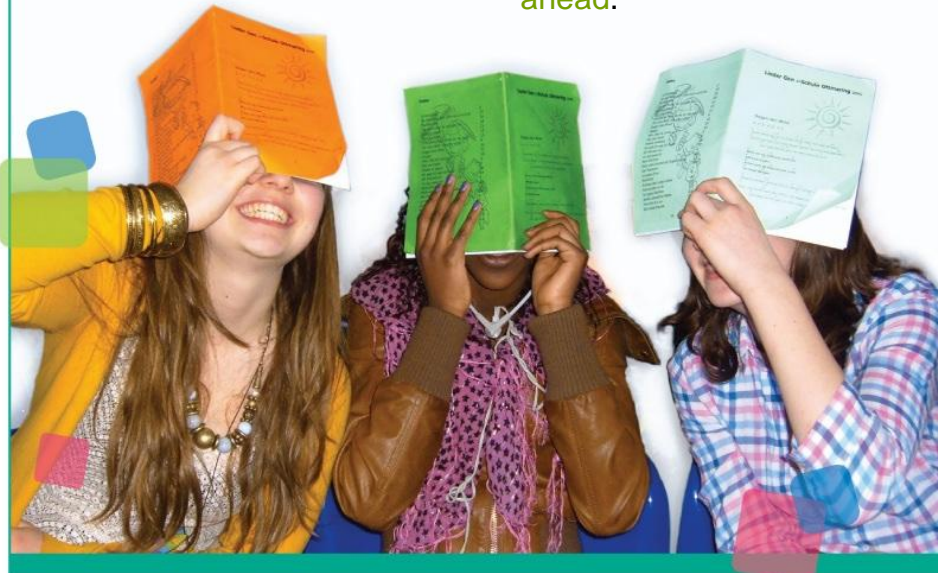
Love has to be **lived concretely**, by serving others, especially those who are right next to us, starting with all the **little things**, the most humble acts of service.
