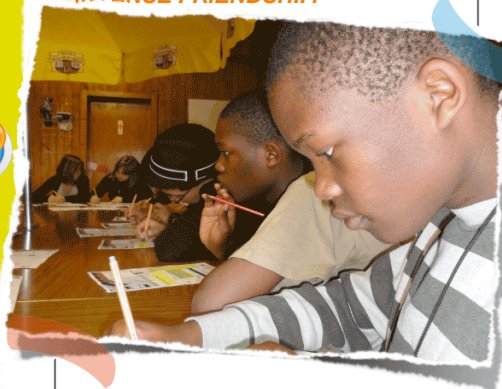
The more we love God, the more intensely we love each person we meet, and the more we love others, the deeper is our love for God.
